My Lord,

Thank you for your letter. I like your new idea. I am enclosing a rough plan with the actual dimensions of the plot of land we own; the present structure and the proposed addition.

The whole plot is 90 feet by 120 ft. The 90 feet being the road boundary: and the whole being rectangular. Note that, if you stand at the gate, the left hand fence will be three feet from the proposed new structure, which seems ample.

As I want you to have this for the meeting on Monday I will say no more except to propose for heating, two electric oil filled radiators, which for safety and labour-saving might fit the bill. May I suggest that plenty air space and big windows are more important in this unique place than much heating. It is the only place I have known where the one grumble completely absent is that about the warmth of the place. The bigger place may change that.
